


# 5 SAFETY STEPS TO CONSIDER BEFORE TAKING YOUR FAMILY ON A ROAD TRIP HOLIDAY

STEP

1

**Check to see that all your vehicle lights are working.**

**You don't want to find out that your head lights don't work while driving at night.**

***A car accident is more likely to happen due to a vehicle's brake lights or indicators not working.***



STEP

2

**Have your battery tested by a professional Auto Electrician.**

**A flat or bad battery will cause your car not to start, possibly leaving you stranded.**

***A faulty battery could also lead to the premature wear of the starter motor.***

STEP

3

**If you are towing a caravan,  
camper or boat, make sure  
your electrical braking system is  
working correctly.**

***The towing braking system not  
working will increase the danger of  
your vehicle not being able to stop.***

STEP

4

**Check that your air conditioning and heater systems are working, including your windscreen demister.**

*A vehicle heating and air conditioning is not only important for your comfort, it also helps with defrosting the windscreen for perfect visibility.*



STEP

5

**Check that your cigarette lighter or power sockets are working in order to recharge your mobile phone.**

***The car's power socket may be the only way of charging your phone, GPS or electronic device while you are away on a camping trip.***
