5 SAFETY STEPS TO CONSIDER BEFORE TAKING YOUR FAMILY ON A ROAD TRIP HOLIDAY





Before you plan a road trip getaway with friends or family, we would like to share some advice on what to check on your vehicle to help ensure you will have a safe trip.

STEP

1

Check to see that all your vehicle lights are working.

You don't want to find out that your head lights don't work while driving at night.

A car accident is more likely to happen due to a vehicle's brake lights or indicators not working.

STEP
2

Have your battery tested by a professional Auto Electrician.

A flat or bad battery will cause your car not to start, possibly leaving you stranded.

A faulty battery could also lead to the premature wear of the starter motor.

STEP
3

**If you are towing a caravan,
camper or boat, make sure
your electrical braking system is
working correctly.**

***The towing braking system not
working will increase the danger of
your vehicle not being able to stop.***

STEP
4

Check that your air conditioning and heater systems are working, including your windscreen demister.

A vehicle heating and air conditioning is not only important for your comfort, it also helps with defrosting the windscreen for perfect visibility.

STEP
5

Check that your cigarette lighter or power sockets are working in order to recharge your mobile phone.

The car's power socket may be the only way of charging your phone, GPS or electronic device while you are away on a camping trip.
